

CONSENT TO INSPECT CARGO SHIPMENTS TRANSPORTED WITH CARGO LINK EXPRESS OR ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the Transportation Security Administration requires all cargo offered for transport by air to have the shipper's consent to screen, search or inspect the cargo.

As an authorized employee of the below named company, I present my company's consent to screen, search or inspect any of our shipments if required, at any point during the transportation supply chain. With my acknowledgement, in the screening process, shipments may potentially undergo physical search or exposure to X-rays by TSA qualified personnel and equipment. I understand that in the absence of this approval, my shipments may not qualify for transportation on any passenger air carrier, which may have an effect on transportation options and service.
